A State educational agency **loc**al educational agency shall use Federal funds received under [Title I, Part A] only to supplement the funds t would, in the absence of such Federal funds, be made available frc State and local sources for the education of students participating in programs assisted under [Title I, Part A], and not to supplant such f (ESEA section 1118(b)(1))

## **Document for Compliance**

Examples of the types of documentati that an LEA to demonstrate that the expenditure is supplemental to other federal and from federal programs include the following:

- x Program and fiscal documentation to protheat, in the absence of federal funds, the EAwould have to eliminate staff or other services.
- x Planning document that shows state and local funds are being used for thegeneral requirements of the student. The supplemental funds are additional services being provided.
- x Implementation of services provided is beyond the basic local and state requirements.
- x Specific policies and procedures related to supplement, not supplant requirements
